



Terms and Conditions of an AUBC Membership

Acknowledgment, Waiver & Release

1. I have read and understood the conditions of membership set out below and agree to abide by them at all times.
2. I agree to pay the annual membership fee as determined by the committee of the AUBC before the 31st of October each year. I will not be entitled to the benefits of membership including the use of the AUBC's facilities if payment is not received by that date.
3. I understand that to be registered with Rowing South Australia (RSA) to compete at regattas, I must pay the annual racing fee (as determined by Rowing SA) to the AUBC before the 31st of October each year, or before the RSA regatta season commences, whichever is earlier.
4. I acknowledge that all membership applications and renewals are subject to the approval of the committee.
5. I acknowledge that the use of all boats will be at the discretion of the Captain and Head Coach. AUBC is a University of Adelaide affiliated sporting club, and as such, preference and priority will usually be given to current Adelaide University students and Intervarsity crews.
6. I acknowledge my liability to pay any fines incurred by the AUBC from either Rowing SA, Adelaide University Sport (AUS) or other governing body if such fine is incurred through my actions.
7. I acknowledge that I will reimburse AUBC for the cost of any repair or replacement to equipment damaged or destroyed as a result of my negligence.
8. I acknowledge that AUBC race entries may only be submitted by authorised personnel of the AUBC.
9. I acknowledge that members are expected to help with the social activities, fundraising, upkeep and cleanliness of the club.
10. I understand that my membership may be terminated by the AUBC committee if I fail to pay any outstanding accounts with the AUBC, am found by the committee to have flagrantly disregarded valid rules and regulations of the AUBC, or am found by the committee to have behaved in an unsporting or otherwise unbecoming way.
11. I acknowledge that my personal equipment is transported and stored at my risk and that AUBC accepts no responsibility for damage to any personal belongings or equipment stored in the sheds. The AUBC does not insure private boats, equipment or other private property.
12. I understand that boat racks are available for hire at both the West Lakes and Torrens sheds, for individual members to store their sculls, at the discretion of the committee. An annual fee is applicable and approval must be granted by the committee.
13. I understand that keys are not currently available to general members. Coaches, members of the committee and squad leaders have keys and open the sheds at regular times to allow members access.
14. I acknowledge that participating in the sport of rowing is an extreme test of a persons' physical and mental limits, and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to pollution, temperatures, water currents, weather hazards, condition of equipment, lack of hydration, actions of other participants, coaches, officials and spectators. I hereby assume the risks of participating in the sport of rowing



15. I certify that I am physically fit and have adequately trained for participation in the sport of rowing and do not have a physical or intellectual impairment that may make my participation unsafe for myself or others.
16. I agree to provide a list of relevant medical conditions from which I may suffer and consent to receiving medical treatment if required.
17. I, my heirs, executors and administrators hereby waive all and any claim, right or cause of action which I or they may have for, or arising out of, injury, death, damage or loss of any description whatsoever which I may suffer in the course of my membership with the AUBC and participation in the sport of rowing.
18. I agree to abide the Rowing Australia Code of Conduct as either an athlete or coach, to submit to drug testing if required.
